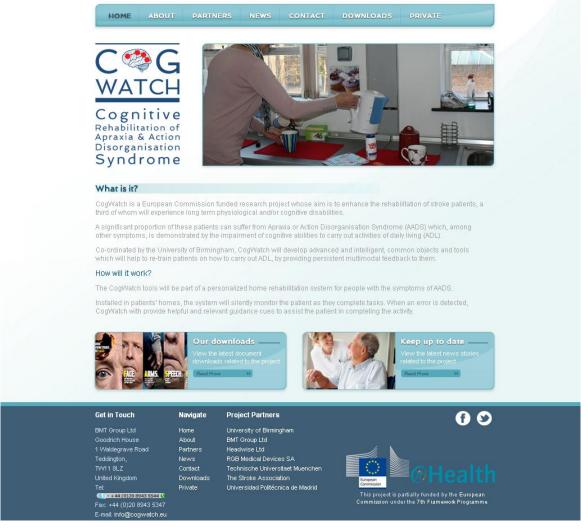


1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Navigation, Structure and Content

Upon entering the home page of the website, site visitors are able to browse the following headers:

1.1.1 **About**

This page frames the context of the project and presents its objectives.

1.1.2 Partners

All seven (7) partners involved in the project are introduced with live links to the home pages of each institution.

1.1.3 News

This section aims to provide information regarding upcoming events as the project progresses.

1.1.4 Contact

The "Contact" page provides information (address, telephone and fax number, email address) for contacting BMT, the Lead Beneficiary responsible for dissemination and exploitation.

1.1.5 Downloads

This page contains documents which have been and will be published about the project, such as press releases, leaflets, publications, public deliverables, etc.

1.1.6 Private

This secured section is accessible to partners in the project by means of a login and password. Shared documents such as meeting minutes, reporting templates etc. are made available.

1.1.7 **Others**

The website also has links to the project's Facebook page and Twitter account which complement the website to publicize project updates.
